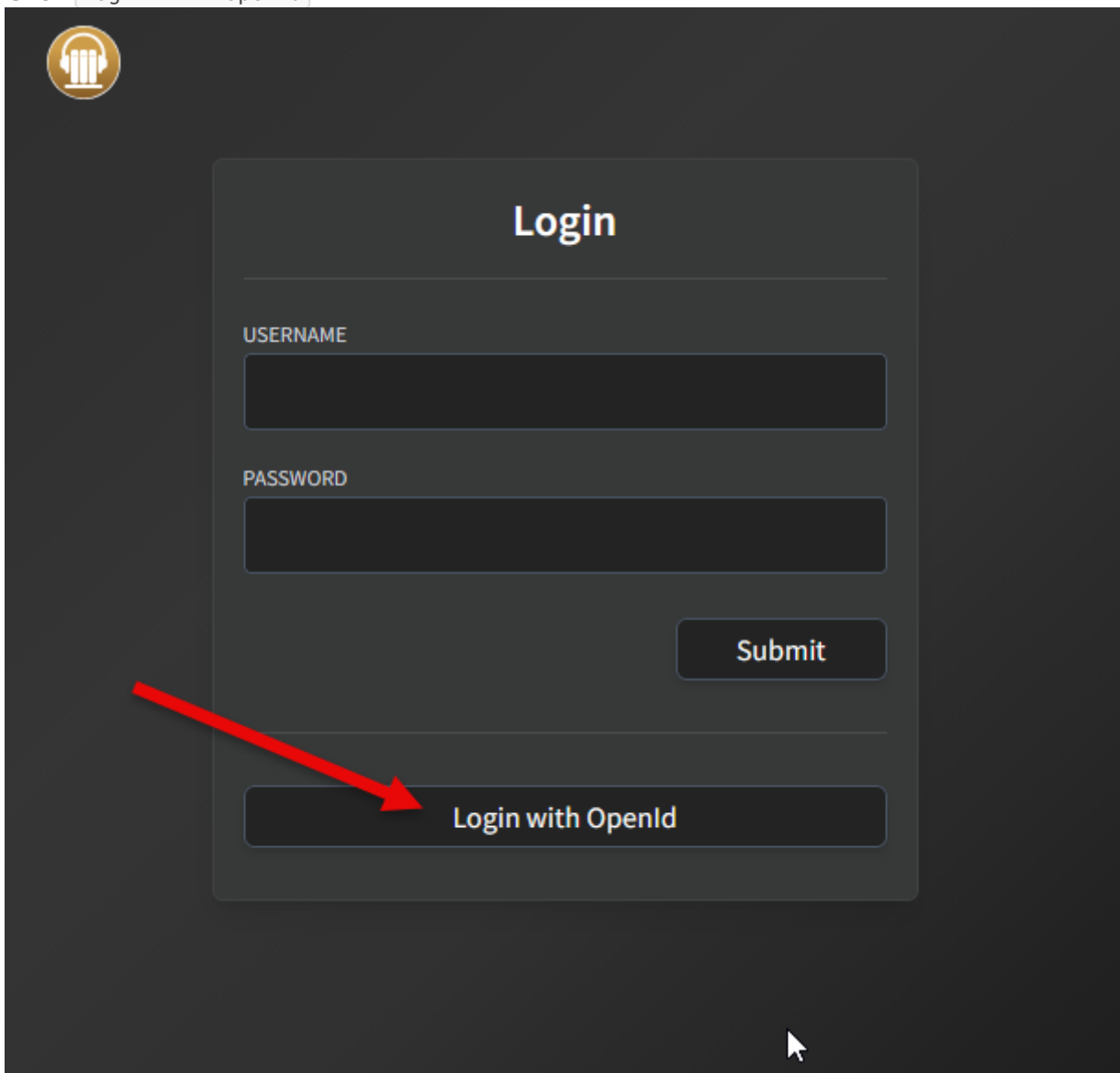

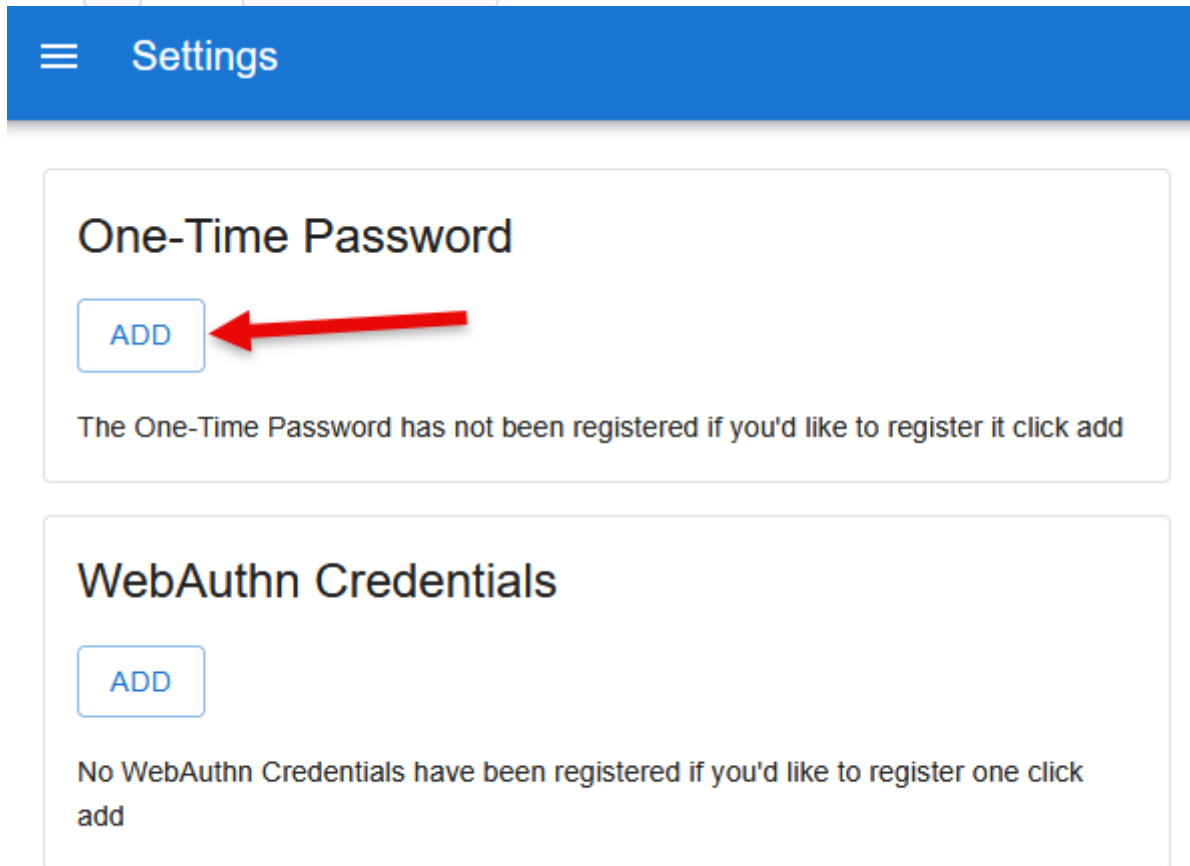

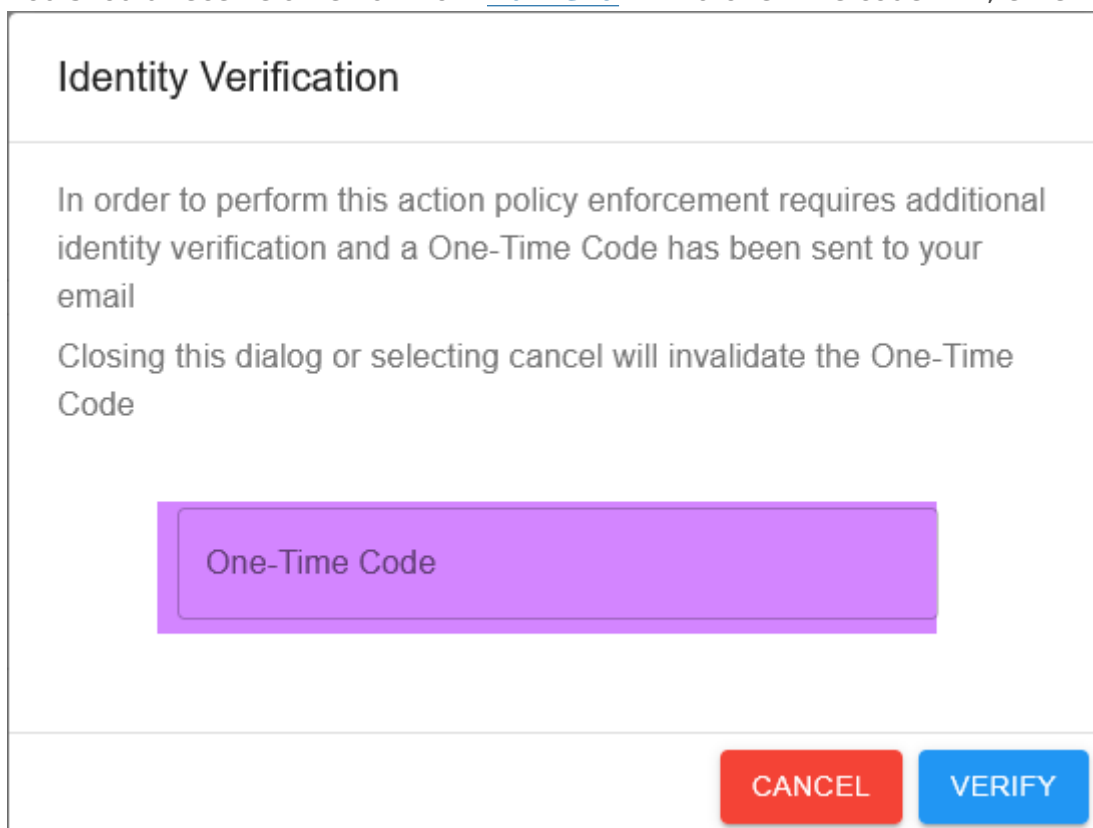
5. Click `Register device`.
